ANNUAL REPORT (2020-21)

INAUGURAL SESSION AND ORIENTATION PROGRAMME



The students who have completed 10+2 are eligible to get enrolled in these courses. These courses are professional and job oriented courses which will open wide opportunities for students both in India and abroad. Many opportunities for government jobs in India as well will be open after completing theses courses.


SCHOOL INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

Students in the college learn to teach. A central aspect of Teacher Education Programme is the school experience programme in schools, popularly known as Teaching Practice for Student Teachers. During Teaching Practice students are given opportunities to observe experienced teachers at work and to develop practical skills, particularly in the areas of planning, teaching class-room management and organizing learning activities for pupils.

It is conducted in four stages: demonstration lessons, pre-practice stage, school experience programme- actual practice stage at practicising schools and evaluation stage. Pre-practice programme was held virtually from 07.07.2020 to 08.08.2020.


