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EDUCATION QUIZ COMPETITION

1. A team will consist of Three participants(one team from a college will be accepted.)
2. Questions will be asked in English language whereas the participants will have the freedom to express in Hindi/Punjabi/English
3. There will be a Preliminary Round to select five teams for the final session. This round will be of written test. The questions will be placed from the areas viz.
General Science, Indian: Geography,
History, Polity, Sports and Cultural Events.
4. There will be 30 Questions in the preliminary round and each question will carry 1 Mark. The duration of Preliminary round will be 40 minutes.
5. The final quiz will consist of questions related to four fundamental subjects of Education are
Education and Development; Contemporary
Issues and Concerns in Secondary Education;
Understanding the Learner and the Learning
Process; Learning Resources and assessment of
Learning and School Management.
6. The quiz will consist of four sessions viz.
Recall Type (5 Rounds). In case of wrong
Response, the question will be transferred to
immediate next team. No negative marking in this
round.
Visual Round(2 Rounds). In case of wrong
Response, the question will be transferred to
immediate next team. No negative marking in this
round.
Multiple Choice Type (5 Rounds).
Non-Transferrable Round. There will be negative
marking in this round.
Rapid Fire Round (one minute duration.)
7. The team to which originally the question is asked
will get 15 seconds to respond to the
question, if the same question is passed to the next
team, 5 seconds will be given to respond to that
question.
8. The decision of the Quiz Master will be final in the
conduct of the Quiz.

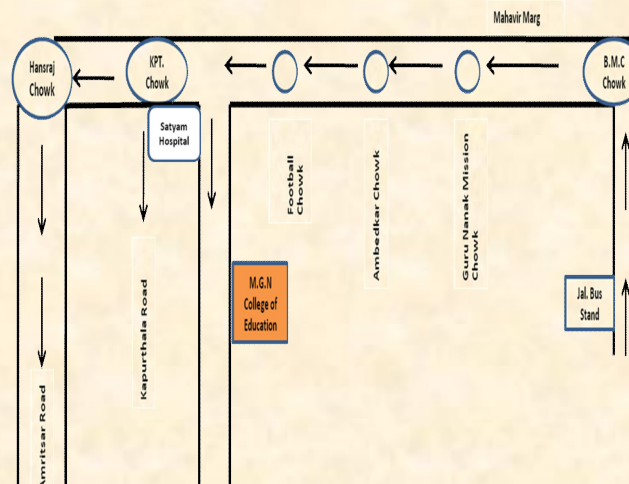

General Rules

- 1. The team competing for overall trophy will have to participate in all categories viz Skill in Teaching, Teaching Aids Preparation, PowerPoint Presentations and Education Quiz.**
2. All the participating teams will bring the authority letter from the head of the institute duly signed along with the Identity Card of the students.
3. Every Team will be given a code at the time of Registration.
4. No participant will indicate his/her name or the name of the institute in the participating event but only the given code.
5. The participants will submit their Teaching Aids/ PowerPoint Presentations to the host Institute.
6. If any college finds it difficult to send their team of participants, in that case individual participants can compete for individual prizes.
7. One participant can participate only in one category.
8. There will be First, Second and Third individual prizes in each category.
9. The host college will not compete for the trophy.
10. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all the participants.
11. Overall Trophy will be awarded to the winning teams on the basis of their performance as team. (7 Credits for First, 5 Credits for Second and 3 Credits for Third Position)
12. The verdict of the judges will be final.

RULES FOR EACH CATEGORY

SKILL-IN-TEACHING COMPETITION

1. Categories for competitions are:
 - Teaching of **Languages: Hindi, Punjabi, English**
 - Teaching of Sciences: **Mathematics, Science** and **Computer Applications**
 - Teaching of **Social Studies, Economics** and **Commerce**
2. Each Team will consist of three participants one each from the above said category.
3. The duration of the lesson will be of 15-20 mins.
4. The participants will have to submit one hard and one soft copy of lesson plans at the time of registration. Participants will write the name of their college on lesson plan to be submitted along with the Authority letter.
5. Two lesson plans will have to be submitted to judges during lesson presentation. Participants will write the codes as issued by the college on the lesson plans to be submitted to the judges.

6. The students of 8th, 9th & 10th classes will be provided.
7. The participants will bring their own teaching aids and requisite material for their lessons.
8. The host institute will make the arrangements of LCD, OHP on their request to be furnished by 28th April, 2012.
9. The lessons can be delivered in any medium-Hindi, Punjabi or English.

ON THE SPOT TEACHING AIDS AND MODELS PREPARATION

1. A team will consist of 3 participants, one from each of the three categories viz.
 - Teaching of **Languages: Hindi, Punjabi, English**
 - Teaching of Sciences: **Mathematics, Science** and **Computer Applications**
 - Teaching of **Social Studies, Economics** and **Commerce**
2. Teaching Aid will be prepared on the spot. No prepared base will be allowed.
3. Time allowed: 2.30 hours.
4. Theme / topic for teaching Aid will be decided by the participants.
5. Material will be arranged by the participants.
6. The teaching aids prepared during competition will be the property of the host College.
7. Judgment will be based on novelty of the idea, technical accuracy and aesthetic presentation.

ON THE SPOT PREPARATION OF POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

1. A team will consist of 3 participants, one from each of the three categories viz.
 - Teaching of **Languages: Hindi, Punjabi, English**
 - Teaching of Sciences: **Mathematics, Science** and **Computer Applications**
 - Teaching of **Social Studies, Economics** and **Commerce**
2. Presentation will be prepared on the spot.
3. Time allowed: 1.00 hour. At the end of each Category Presentation will be compiled in the folder and will be handed over to the judges for evaluation. (This will be displayed on LCD Projector for judgment.)
4. Theme /topic for the PPT's will be decided by the participants.
5. No storage device will be carried by the participants.
6. No Internet Access. Use only MS-Office 2007/2003.
7. Minimum 10 slides should be prepared.
8. Credit will be given for novelty of ideas, technical accuracy and aesthetic presentation.
